



## 2019 Rosé Wine

This is our tenth release of Rosé and we could not be happier with the results. This is always one of our most popular wines and will sell out quickly so do not wait as supply is limited! The August Briggs Rosé was produced with mélange of grapes grown in both Napa, Sonoma and Contra Costa counties. The grapes were harvested beginning September 5 to September 28. We started with some juice bled off the skins of some Pinot Noir from Sonoma County and then bled off Zinfandel juice from grapes right here in Calistoga and added in some bled off juice from our new Malbec from Contra Costa County. A wild and unique blend for sure!

The color shimmers with a shade between light pink and highlights of persimmon. This refreshing rosé shows vibrant cranberry, citrus rind and a hint of pomegranate in the aroma that is effusive upon a few swirls of the glass. Lip-smacking flavors of fresh apricot mixed with white cherry and citrus dance together in harmony. This wine is juicy, refreshing and elegant all at the same time. This vintage is much more round and soft on the palate than previous vintage of our rosé which makes it great for just sipping on its own.
